Maine Winter Sports Center Announces Youth Wilderness Trips

This summer the Maine Winter Sports Center introduces overnight wilderness trips for 11-14 year old County youth. The trips will take participants into wilderness areas on hiking and canoeing trips. The goal of the program is to familiarize youth with the incredible natural resources of northern Maine while providing a hands-on approach to learning about wilderness skills and ethics. A canoe trip through the Fish River chain of Lakes will take place from July 13th – 15th. There will be a hiking trip to Gulf Hahas (near Brownville Junction) in from July 27th – 28th. To sign up call the MWSC office during normal business hours at 492-1444. No previous experience or involvement in MWSC programs is necessary. Participants must be proficient swimmers for the canoe trip.

Fish River Chain of Lakes – July 13th – 15th

This 3 day, 2 night trip originates at Long Lake and will continue through the chain of lakes connected by the Fish River, ending at Eagle Lake. Participants will learn the basics of paddling, water safety, navigation, campcraft and cooking, and Leave No Trace wilderness ethics. Trip fee will include the use of all canoe gear, tents, and all other group gear. Sleeping bags and pads will also be available if needed.

Camp Fee: \$40

To sign up call the MWSC office during normal business hours at 492-1444. **July 9th is the last day we will be taking sign-ups for this trip.**

Gulf Hahas – July 27th – 28th

This 2 day, 1 night trip will explore Gulf Hahas and Katahdin Iron Works Historic Site. Gulf Hahas is referred to by some as the “Grand Canyon of Maine” with many gorges and waterfalls that can be seen from the hiking trail. Participants will learn the basics of backcountry hiking, campcraft and cooking, and Leave No Trace wilderness ethics. Trip fee will include the use of all tents, packs, and all other group gear. Sleeping bags and pads will also be available if needed.

Camp Fee: \$40
